CCLIX-OptIMA® system. Since that time, more than 300,000 document images have become available for online viewing and printing.

In addition, index records only (deeds, mortgages, etc.) for Real Estate recordings are available back to May 1993. Plans are currently being developed to

provide document images back to this date.

In September, 1999, CCLIX-OptIMA® was implemented for Security Agreement access. Currently, 31,000 document images are available, with over 110,000 index records back to 1988 in total available for actual viewing.
