The Shelby County Clerk's Office is pleased to present eCCLIX®, the Internet version of CCLIX®. Today, the system known as CCLIX® ("clicks"), County Clerk Indexing, is being utilized in almost two-thirds of Kentucky's County Clerk offices. Attorneys, paralegals, title clerks, realtors, genealogists, surveyors, and appraisers have grown to depend upon the CCLIX® system to provide the fastest possible access to public records archived in the Kentucky County Clerk's office.

With eCCLIX®, an Internet-ready PC

and printer, registered users can now view or print any online document right in their own home or office. For last minute title follow-ups, why not have an eCCLIX® terminal right at your closing table?

CCLIX-OptIMA®, the document imaging module was first implemented in 1998. Since then, 300,000 document images have been made accessible.

Back file projects have been identified to rapidly expand this database.

In February, 2004, the first back file project was completed and added over 3,000 PLAT images to the database. In April, 2004, the database will be expanded to include document images and index records back to 1961.
